## LIBRARY SERVICES 2019

Over many years the ICFR has maintained a technical library with collections important to plantation forestry research and management. This is the most complete such collection in South Africa.

Forestry South Africa, recognising the importance of this library, have undertaken to contribute towards the cost of the library so that it remains accessible to its members and to students at South African tertiary institutes.

The ICFR library has a complete collection of ICFR reports (including all Bulletins and Technical Notes issued 2002-2018 available online). The library subscribes to key forestry journals, maintains a book collection and houses various reports (issue in series and ad hoc) including relevant 'grey literature'.

An ICFR staff member is available to assist library users in accessing these resources. The library is open every morning, 08h00 to 13h00, Monday to Friday. Visits are welcome to view the collection in the library and, although paper copy is not available on loan, the library has scanning and photocopy facilities (at a charge cover cost) and where available electronic format can be supplied.
